**TWENTY-THIRD ANNUAL MEETING**

We are pleased to announce that the 23rd Annual Meeting of the Walter Burley Griffin Society of America will be held on Saturday, 14 September, investigating the architecture around the picturesque summer retreats of Geneva Lake and Delavan Lake in southern Wisconsin. The Saturday morning session and lunch will take place at the Lake Geneva Country Club, on the south shore of Geneva Lake at W3398 S. Lakeshore Drive, Lake Geneva. Designed by Spencer & Powers in 1915, the concrete-block clubhouse remains much as it was constructed, magnificently sited. There is plenty of parking on the grounds. As usual, the meeting will begin at 9:00am. Lecture topics include the organic architecture of John Randal McDonald of Racine, by Dave Erickson; a recently restored Wright System-Built house in Shorewood, Wisconsin, by Nicholas Hayes; and the Summer Houses of the Prairie School, by Paul Kruty.

At the conclusion of the lectures, lunch will be served at the clubhouse. Following visits to several sites around Geneva and Delavan lakes, including Spencer & Powers' Horticultural Hall and Henry Ives Cobb's Yerkes Observatory, we will end at Frank Lloyd Wright's spectacular Jones estate, "Penwern," at 3335 South Shore Drive, Lake Delavan, an ensemble of structures from 1900 to 1903. There will be a reception with light refreshments. The day will end at approximately 5:00pm.

For those of you who are staying overnight, if you haven't done so already, we recommend booking accommodations as soon as possible. And, of course, check the Griffin website for updates.
